10. Helpful tips after reading the report



Every tip you check off helps you avoid unwelcome surprises later. The more you check, the safer your car deal.

1. Check vehicle history
 1. You've already done this – great start! Here's what to do next:
 2. Use the tips in this section when you check the car in person.

2. Get a professional inspection. An expert mechanic can spot hidden issues you might miss. Here's what to do next:
 1. Book a pre-purchase inspection at an independent or authorised service
 2. Ask the mechanic to check key systems: engine, brakes, suspension, electronics
 3. Request written notes or a report of any issues found
3. Check if the mileage matches. Make sure the mileage in this report matches the car's odometer readings. Here's what to do next:
 1. Check the odometer reading against the mileage in the report
 2. Watch for signs of tampering (worn pedals, suspicious dashboard fixes)
 3. Ask the seller about any differences
4. Ask for service records. Service records show how well the car has been looked after. Here's what to do next:
 1. Ask the seller for the car's service book or maintenance records
 2. Check for regular oil changes, filter replacements, and timing belt work
 3. Note any missing or overdue services
